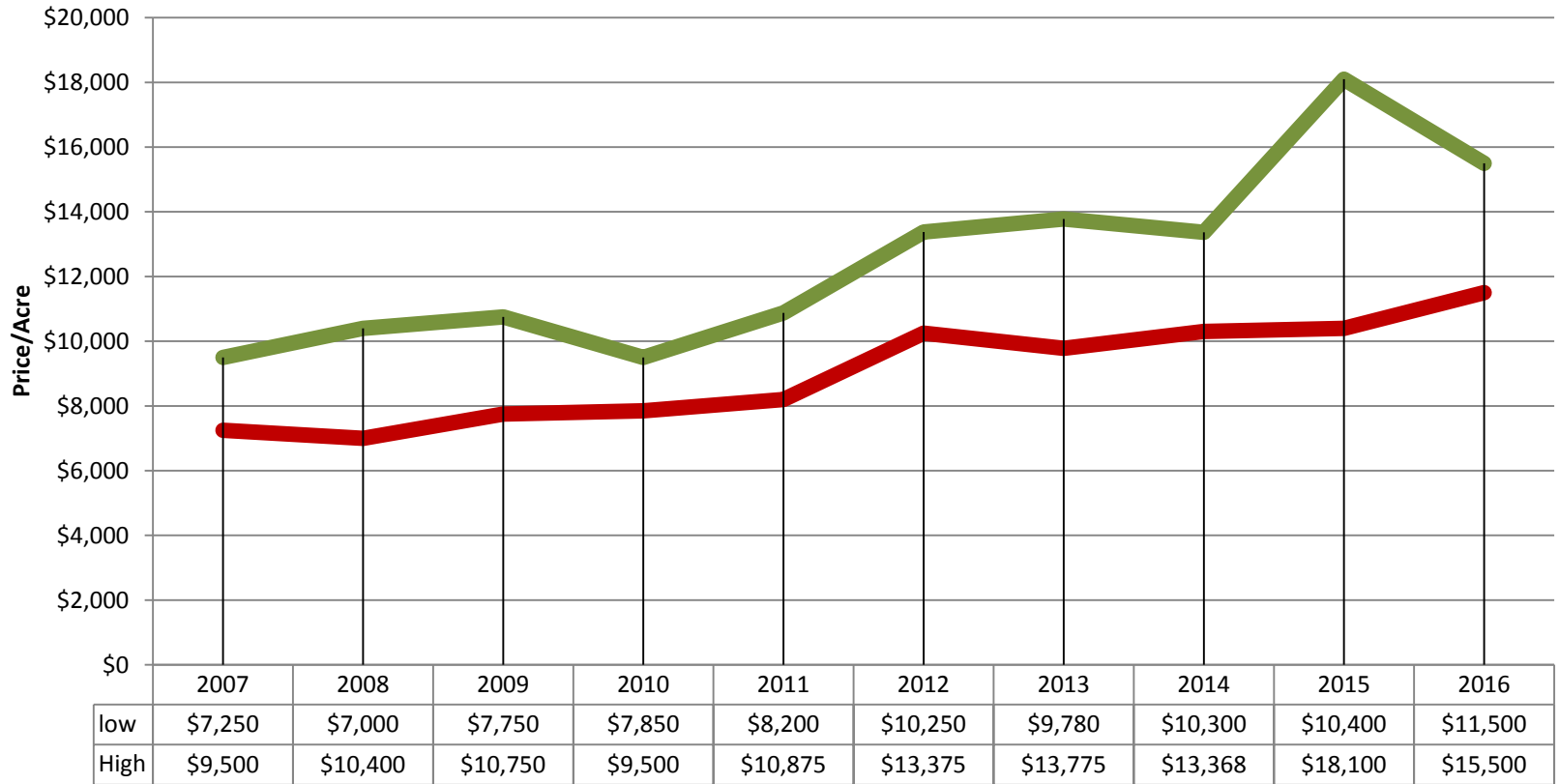

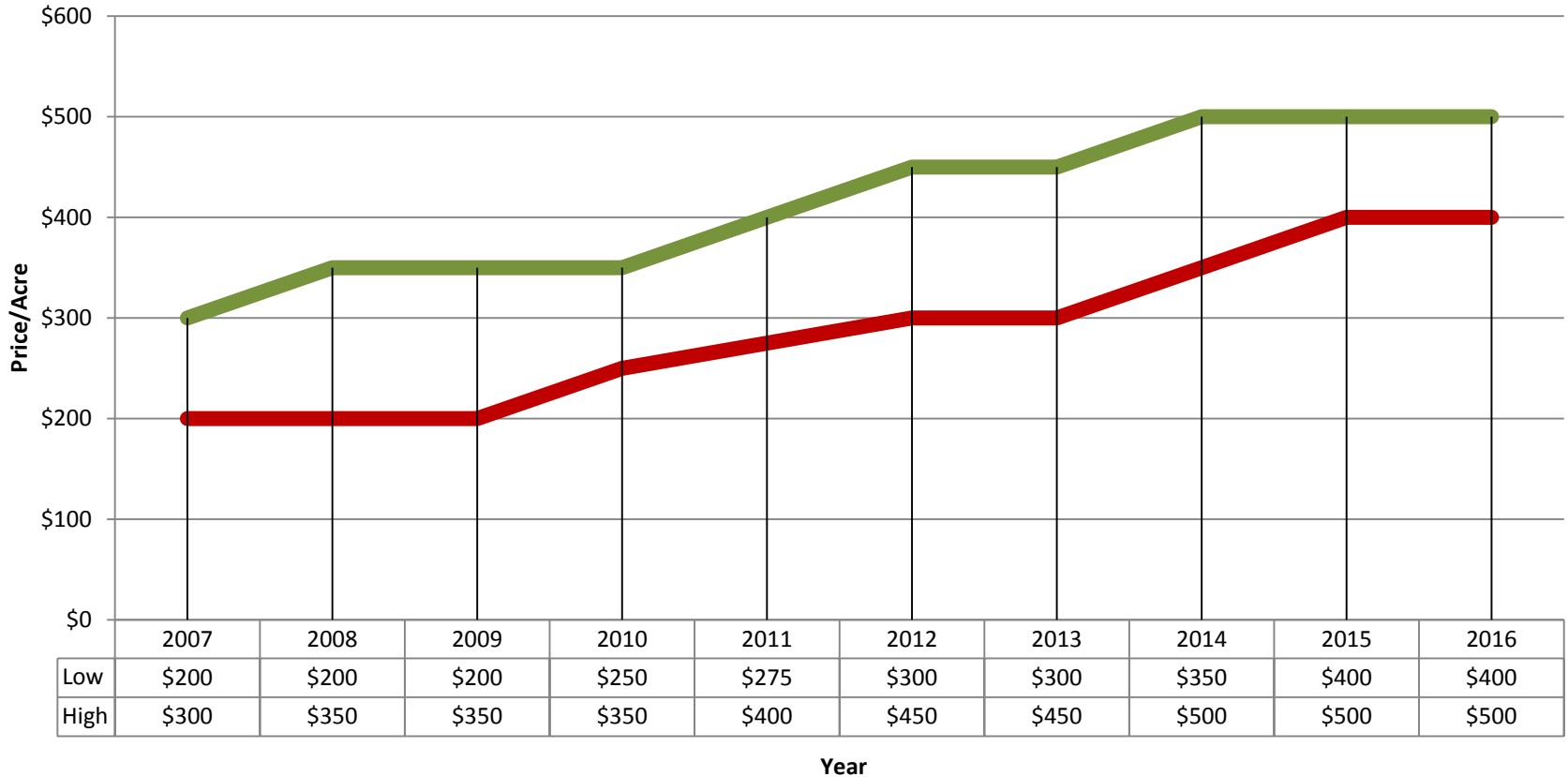
## Price / Net Acre Trend

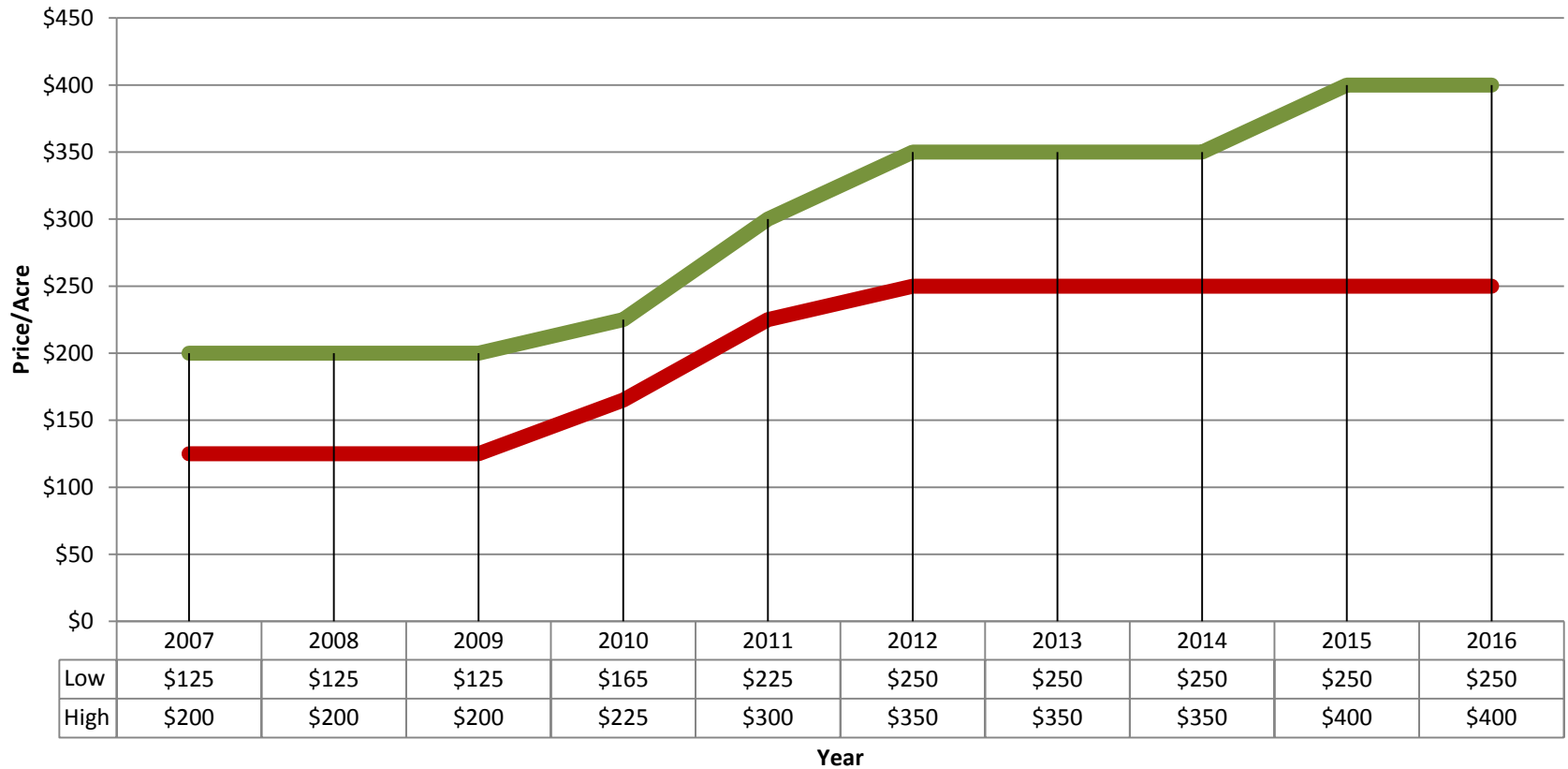

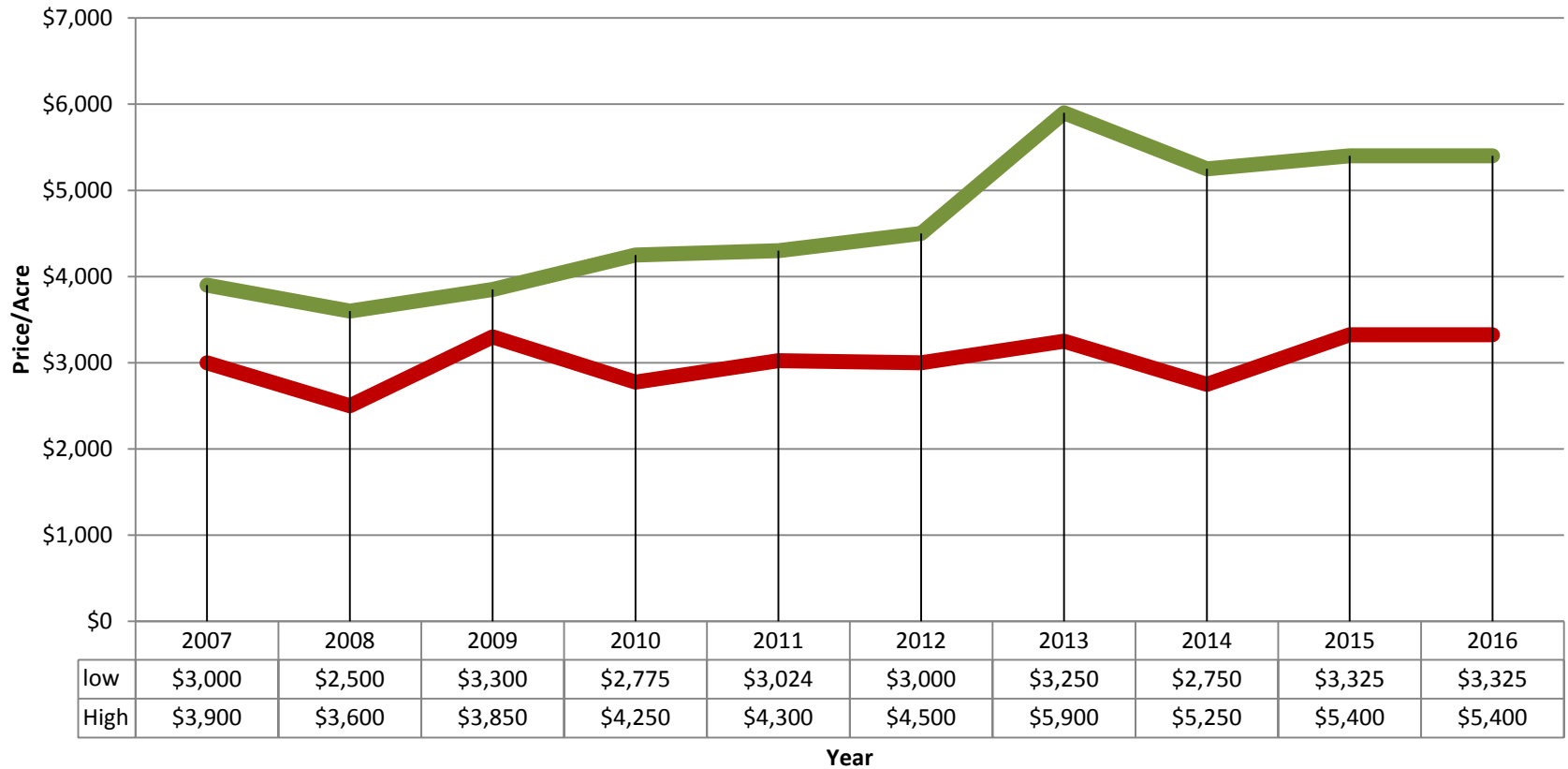
