
Dairy Industry Overview

- 2017 milk near breakeven till late in the year
 - Price softened late in 2017 and into early part of 2018
- 2017 Dairy Herd Trends
 - Arizona increased 3.6%
 - Nationwide increased 1%
- Milk Production Trends
 - Arizona up 2.3% from 4th Qtr '16
 - Nationwide up 1.1% from 4th Qtr '16




Prices Received for All Milk – States and United States: December 2017 with Comparisons



AZ Milk Production Per Cow per USDA's AZ Agricultural Statistics






Milk to Feed Ratio- US

Source- UW Madison

- Measures how much feed can be purchased with 1lb of milk
- Historically 2.5 or higher means profit/expansion, 2 or lower means contraction
- 2017 ended at 2.38





Arizona Dairy Values

- Sales activity very limited- 1 sale in 2017 shows stable market
- Saudi style facilities
 - Saudi facility sales: \$1,700 to \$2,737 per cow
- Conventional style dairies
 - No recent sales noted
 - Older sales range from \$1,000 to \$1,500 per cow
- Values vary depending on land base, replacement facilities and on-site housing



Rental Rates

- Conventional dairies
 - \$8-13 per wet head/month
- Saudi style dairies- limited marketed data due to no vacancy.
 - \$15-\$17 per wet head/month
- Good cow cooling, on-site housing and calf/heifer facilities command more rent per cow



Dairy Industry Outlook

- 2018 milk price softened
- Feed costs remains low- inputs are manageable
- Competition from alternative products for consumer dollars
